

Truth be told, the Blue Lightning II Series was the inspiration for the Super Seeker line. Its construction created massive power that gives the angler the advantage over fish of any size.

These rods were designed with inshore species in mind. Those tough structure oriented fish hide away in rock crevasses, kelp forests, and some of the most unruly structure, waiting for a meal to swim by. Our rods have the actions necessary to cast baits into the right spots with accuracy at the same time having the power and backbone that the angler needs to power the fish out of hiding and to the landing net!

We have chosen lightweight EVA foam grips, graphite reel seats, and ultra hard TiCH ring guides accented in blue. Each of our Blue Lightning II blanks are coated with a durable transparent blue poly-urethane coating* that provides a long lasting glossy finish while providing UV protection for the glass and graphite fiber.

Each and every Seeker blank is manufactured in the USA and using top quality components from around the world, they are assembled in the USA as well.

(* Do not use acetone when wiping down or cleaning our blanks. It is suggested that rod builders use denatured alcohol for cleanup during the rod building process)
